3	Formal postgraduate or other tertiary level courses, the lecture hours (or equivalent) of which exceeds 60 hours. This can be claimed in three consecutive years	20 hours
4	Professional activities performed in the course of practicing the profession in regular employment or otherwise requiring a certain quantum of study and analysis of new subject matter	15 hours
5	Contributing to engineering knowledge which is of direct relevance to industry through research and dissemination	20 hours
6	Technical (in a broad sense) presentation at conferences, seminars, symposia, workshops etc. that require the acquisition of knowledge through books, journals, manuals, codes of practice, industry best-practices, etc.	20 hours
7	Serving on boards/committees tasked with the formulation of policy that would enhance regional or national development	15 hours
8	The time engineers spent/ engaged in the usage of online technologies and materials that are relevant to the design or development of solutions to complex engineering problems. Such activities to collect information on Engineering Related Matters of Importance in the Practice of Engineering, will be evaluated as part of the competencies required in engineering roles.	20 hours
